Transportation Committee Meeting
Thursday, June 3, 2021 @12:00 p.m. Central Time**

MEETING MINUTES

Judge Executive John Phelps of Cumberland County called the meeting to order at 12:02 p.m. in the Large Conference Room of the Lake Cumberland Area Development District in Russell Springs, Kentucky via Zoom conference due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic with 22 persons attending. Judge Phelps welcomed everyone then turned the meeting over to Mr. Kevin Young, Department of Highways District 4.

Mr. Young gave project status updates for Green and Taylor Counties. Mr. Young also discussed projects in the construction phase as well as projects completed. With no questions or comments Judge Phelps turned the meeting over to Mr. Jeff Dick, Department of Highways District 8.

Mr. Dick gave project status updates for Adair, Casey, Clinton, Cumberland, McCreary, Pulaski, Russell, and Wayne Counties. Mr. Dick also discussed Future Lettings (Proposed Dates), Projects in Design Status, Ongoing Construction Status, FD05 (MP) Resurfacing Project, HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) – Project (Federal funding safety projects) as well as projects completed.

Next Judge Phelps turned the meeting over to Ms. Whitney Frost, LCADD GIS Specialist. Ms. Frost stated that the Transportation Cabinet has asked the LCADD to complete a local road review with each city and county. Ms. Frost commented that she will be reaching out to several of our cities and counties in the next few months to get started on this project. With much discussion, Judge Phelps thanked Ms. Frost.

Next Mrs. Kasey Hoskins discussed the DRAFT Strategic Highway Investment Formula for Tomorrow (SHIFT) 2022 Prioritization Plan Preliminary Draft and how sponsorships were selected and how the selection of the Boost Points will be conducted. The purpose of this document is to provide a plan to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) for the selection of sponsorship projects and boost points allocation in the 2022 Statewide Prioritization Process. The prioritization will be used as input for the Recommended KYTC Highway Plan, to be submitted to the next session of the Kentucky General Assembly in 2022. SHIFT is a prioritization model that will bring balance and dependability to Kentucky's over programmed highway plan. With no questions or comments Judge Executive Gary Robertson made a motion to approve the SHIFT 2022 Prioritization Plan Preliminary Draft. Seconded by Judge Executive Gale Cowan. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Next Mrs. Hoskins discussed the Public Involvement Plan for FY 2021. Mrs. Hoskins stated that this is one of the two plans that is done at the end of every year which includes information that has been collected throughout the year such as updating memberships, bylaws, how meetings are conducted, goals and objectives, etc. The updated information is put into the plan and is posted to the Lake Cumberland Area Development District's website. With no questions or comments a motion was made by Judge Executive Gary Robertson to approve the Public Involvement Plan for FY 2021. Seconded by Mrs. Judy Price. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

Next Mrs. Hoskins discussed the Regional Transportation Asset Inventory FY 2021. This is the second plan that is done at the end of each year. This plan also provides data updates to the Asset Inventory for our major freight users, inter-mobile truck parking inventory, etc. With no questions or comments Judge Executive Gale Cowan made a motion to approve the Regional Transportation Asset Inventory FY 2021 Plan. Seconded by Judge Ricky Craig. All in Favor. Motion Carried.

In Other Business, Mrs. Kasey Hoskins stated that there were a couple of nominations for members to join and fill vacant voting positions. The first nomination is for Kim Vaught to be put in as a Planning/Zoning Commission and Organization Representative. Mrs. Hoskins stated that Ms. Vaught is a Planning and Zoning Coordinator at the City of Somerset. The next nomination is for Michelle Perry to be put in as the Tourism and Parks Representative. Mrs. Hoskins stated that Ms. Perry is the McCreary County Tourism Director. With these being the only two nominations in the areas in which they represent a motion was made by Mrs. Judy Price to approve these two members. Seconded by Judge Executive Jimmie Greene.

Next Mr. Neal Cundiff, Director of the Planning Department let everyone know that as of August 1st he will be retiring. Mr. Cundiff went on to tell the committee that he started in FY 96-97 in the Planning Department. Mr. Cundiff then thanked Mrs. Hoskins and the Committee for all the hard work that they have put into Transportation/Planning.

Next Mr. Darryl McGaha, Executive Director of Lake Cumberland Area Development District commented that he will be retiring August 1st as well. Mr. McGaha thanked Neal for all the work in leadership that he has done and Mrs. Hoskins for her work in transportation. Mr. McGaha stated that he feels like everything will continue to flow forward as transitions will be made. Mr. McGaha thanked the Committee and stated that he has really appreciated the time that he has spent working closely with the Transportation Committee.

Mrs. Hoskins reminded everyone that the next meeting will be Thursday, September 2nd at 12:00 Central Time. With there being no other business Judge Phelps thanked everybody for attending the virtual meeting. A motion was made by Mayor Eddie Thomas to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Judge Executive Gale Cowan. Meeting adjourned at 12:43 p.m. Central Time.

Introduction/Overview

The purpose of this document is to provide a final plan to the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) for the sponsorship and prioritization of projects in the 2022 Statewide Prioritization Process. The prioritization will be used as input for the Recommended KYTC Highway Plan, to be submitted to the next session of the Kentucky General Assembly in 2022.

The KYTC has developed a more data-driven, objective and collaborative approach to determine the state's transportation funding priorities. Strategic Highway Investment Formula for Tomorrow (SHIFT) is a prioritization model that will bring balance and dependability to Kentucky's over programmed highway plan. SHIFT uses quantitative data such as crashes, fatalities, traffic volumes, delays, and employment to assess the benefits of planned projects and compare them to each other. The program also includes collaboration with local leaders throughout the process to help shape regional funding priorities. Through this collaboration, projects will be selected for prioritization by being sponsored at the regional or Area Development District (ADD) level, Highway District Office (HDO) level and Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) level.

The KYTC Continuous Highway Analysis Framework (CHAF) identifies approximately 2,800 active transportation projects. In an effort to make this large list of projects more manageable for prioritization purposes, KYTC developed a formula based on 2010 Census numbers, public road lane miles and number of counties per agency to determine the number of projects each ADD, HDO and MPO could sponsor. The result will be approximately 1,100 projects statewide selected for sponsorship into SHIFT by the ADDs, HDOs, and MPOs. Using this formula with the numbers in the LCADD, it has been determined that the LCADD Regional Transportation Committee (RTC) will be allotted 39 projects for regional sponsorship.

The projects selected for regional sponsorship will be submitted to the KYTC Central Office Planning and loaded into the SHIFT formula. This process will calculate the project scores based

on safety, asset management, congestion, economic growth and benefit/cost. The result will be a list of projects selected based upon projected schedules and available funding for project phases to be identified in the Recommended Highway Plan.

KYTC will also produce regional lists, not selected through the statewide process. These projects will be scored in the SHIFT regional model, which will use weighted values for data available: safety, asset management, congestion, economic growth, benefit/cost ratio, and District and Local (ADD/MPO) priorities. Approximately twenty-five (25%) of the projects on the regional lists can be selected to receive 15 priority points. Projects not selected get zero points. Projects selected by both the District and the ADD will get a 'turbo boost' (the maximum combined points). Projects identified to receive priority points should meet the selection criteria identified by the prioritization plans developed by the District and ADD.

Timeline

- October & November 2020 – Virtual Local Meetings through Zoom to update project lists in CHAF database
- April 2021 – Virtual Local Meetings through Zoom to discuss priority projects for sponsorship selection
- May 6, 2021 – Virtual RTC Meeting through Zoom to approve sponsorship projects and submit to KYTC
- June 7, 2021 – Submit DRAFT Prioritization Plan to KYTC discussed and approved at the March June 3rd RTC Meeting
- September 2, 2021 – Provide update on prioritization process to RTC and identify 25% of the projects for boost points to complete regional prioritization
- September 6, 2021 – Submit final regional project list to KYTC
- October 4, 2021 – Submit FINAL Prioritization Plan to KYTC

Project Selection Criteria/Methodology

Throughout the prioritization process, coordination efforts between the LCADD, District 4 & 8, and KYTC Central Office Planning will be necessary to ensure the process of setting priorities and having clear communication regarding SHIFT guidelines and identifying the projects that are more important to the region. Good communication between the LCADD and the Highway Districts is extremely critical during the sponsorship phase and the boost phase in order to maximize the potential for projects to receive future funding.

During October and November, LCADD and the Highway District staff met virtually with the County Judge Executives of each county to review the county active CHAF projects. During April, LCADD and the Highway District staff met virtually with the County Judge Executives of each county to determine county priorities. Discussion took place during each of the local meetings on how the RTC might determine projects for regional sponsorship. In the past, regional priorities were selected evenly amongst the counties. This method was presented at the local meetings. LCADD will select up to 39 projects to sponsor. It was decided by consensus

at the local meeting that each of the 10 counties in LCADD will sponsor up to 3 projects and the remaining 9 will be projects of regional significance and will be decided by the full RTC. The RTC reviewed and approved the 29 local priorities on May 6th as well as selected an additional 6 projects to approve as sponsored projects. The LCADD RTC approved 35 total projects for sponsorship on May 6th.

Project Boost Criteria/Methodology

Upon completion of the KYTC's statewide selection process, a regional list of projects will be provided to the RTC for prioritization input. The RTC will meet September 2, 2021 to complete this phase of the regional prioritization process. The RTC will select 25% of the projects from the list to boost. Projects will be presented in an order of highest score to lowest score determined by the KYTC scoring method. Based on those scores, the top project in each county with regional significance will be highlighted. Also, other regionally significant projects with a high score will be highlighted. The proposed boost listing will begin the discussion.

The following criteria will serve as the basis to project consideration for boost points:

- **Regional Significance:** The RTC should review the list for potential boost projects that improve the region's major routes.
- **Highway Plan Projects:** Projects from current Highway Plan with project phases in or beyond the Right of Way phase (could also be in Utility Relocation phase or Construction phase): These projects have already reached a certain level of commitment that make it difficult to disregard for future funding. Coordination efforts with the Highway Districts revealed these criteria will be an important factor in their selection process.
- **Analysis of Data:** As a final option for selecting boost projects, the RTC can review the data components compiled by KYTC for SHIFT evaluations. The individual components (congestion or traffic counts, safety or critical rate factor, freight percentages, asset management or roadway characteristics) as a whole, maybe did not score high, but as a single factor could have scores that rank the project in the more critical range for a roadway of its type.

The RTC will review the proposed boost listing and consider criteria during their discussion.

Public Involvement/Feedback

The ADD will solicit public input throughout the prioritization process by consulting with state legislators, local officials, transportation stakeholders, the LCADD Board of Director's (BOD) and the RTC. Information on SHIFT will be provided through the ADD's email, RTC meetings and BOD meetings. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, meetings will be held virtually through Zoom with each county to review SHIFT and projects to be considered for sponsorship to SHIFT and obtain input on those projects. Input will also be obtained on sponsorship projects, selection criteria and priority boost points at the virtual regional transportation committee meetings. All BOD

and RTC meetings are advertised by, LCADD email, LCADD online calendar and LCADD Newsletters. These meetings are open to the public.
